Tip of the Month

Building Writing Skills Below are some skills your child needs to know when writing:

- Write from left to right with letters touching writing lines.
- Place spaces in between words-fingers, Popsicle sticks, etc.
- Use upper and lowercase letters.
- Use punctuation at the end of a sentence.
- Use drawing, guided writing, and dictating to write.
- Use letter/sound knowledge, sight words, and word walls to write simple words.
- Write correct beginning and ending consonant sounds.
